## Model 2

### 1-2 DAYS PER WEEK WITH ALTERNATING WEEKS THREE IN-PERSON COHORTS



**Option for:** Elementary, Middle and High Schools

#### Summary:

- Three in-person cohorts, one remote.
- Provides regularity on days per week with some variation by week (e.g. Group A is in-person every Tuesday, as well as on Monday in week 1 and Friday in week 3; Group B is in-person every Wednesday, as well as on Friday in week 1 and Monday in week 2; Group C is in-person every Thursday, as well as Friday in Week 2 and Monday in week 3).
- **Group A, Group B, Group C:** in-person learning 1-2 days per week (5 days every 3 weeks); remote learning for non-in person days.
- **Group D:** remote every day; consists of students who opt out of in-person instruction.

# Safety Measures (as of 8/5/2020)

- 1) NYC DOE will provide PPE to all schools
- 2) Students will be expected to wear face masks for duration of school day, except when eating lunch
- 3) NYC DOE will increase sanitation practices, including daily cleaning of school buildings
- 4) NYC DOE in conjunction with Dept of Health will do testing and contact tracing if there is a positive case of Covid
- 5) If there is 1 positive case of Covid - person who tested positive and people in their cohort will quarantine for 14 days. These students will receive remote instruction
- 6) If 2 positive cases of Covid - school will be closed for at least 25 hours for cleaning. Students will receive remote instruction until DOE and Dept Health says to reopen the school
- 7) In order to minimize the risk of transmission, there is a strong likelihood that students will not transition from classroom to classroom throughout the day
